The 18 associations reporting this year to NCPSA represented a total number of 6,663 member schools with an enrollment of 2,288,848 students. This included a total number of 4,407 accredited schools with 2,049,328 students. A comparison of the data from the 17 accrediting associations for the last year shows a slight reduction of students in accredited schools and an increase in the number of accredited schools.

REGIONAL BREAKDOWN

According to the state data, the states with the most total members, including non-accredited, pre-accredited schools, and accredited schools, were Florida (1024), Pennsylvania (747), New Jersey (565), New York (518), and Wisconsin (359).

Those states with the most schools accredited by NCPSA associations were Florida (762), Pennsylvania (659), New Jersey (476), New York (366), Maryland (182), California (178), Georgia (168), North Carolina (132), Tennessee (113), Wisconsin (109), and District of Columbia (93).

The number of regionally accredited schools represents 9.5% of the NCPSA Accredited Schools, in addition, those accredited by other associations represent 6.6%.




